

Promising years to catch up with

- Qatar is expected to award new projects in 2018 worth QR29 bn (\$7.9 bn)
- The total construction project pipeline in Qatar including all mega projects with a value above \$25 mn, stands at QR924.1 bn (\$253.9 bn)
- Nearly QR12.5 bn (\$3.43 bn) has been allocated to water and electricity networks, sewerage, roads and other related infrastructure between 2018 and 2020
- QR11.2 bn (\$3.08 bn) has been assigned for completion of new stadiums
- The government plans to spend QR45.5 bn (\$12.5 bn) to build affordable houses across the country by 2022



THE VENUE

Doha Exhibition & Convention Center

Project Qatar 2019 will be held at the Doha Exhibition & Convention Center (DECC), a state-of-the-art venue located at the heart of the Qatari capital.

The 47,700 SQM venue includes five column-free halls spreading over 30,000 SQM and contains a main foyer, bistros, public restrooms, prayer rooms, a loading zone, storage, circulation space, and a car park that can accommodate nearly 5,000 vehicles and a multi-function hall. Located in the lively West Bay area, the DECC is easily accessible from several routes and will be connected to the Sheraton Park through an underground tunnel that will bring visitors to the naturally crescent-shaped Doha Corniche. The venue is also located 15 minutes away from Hamad International Airport and numerous hotels.
